

Who is Nano Nagle?

Nano (Honora) Nagle was born in Ballygriffin, County Cork, Ireland in 1718. Nano opened a school for thirty-five girls in a two-room cabin, an action that was punishable by death under the English Penal Laws. This began her great and dangerous career in education. Nano opened many schools. She educated children during the day and visited and nursed the sick by night. This led to Nano being known as the “Lady with the Lantern.” Nano founded the Sisters of the Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary on December 24, 1775. Presentation Sisters staffed St. Vincent de Paul School for 30 years and lived here, the building in which Nano Nagle Children’s Center now resides.

Infant/ Toddler Program

~6 weeks to 23 months~

Infants will play and interact to learn about the world around them. They will experience a variety of age-appropriate toys to stimulate their growing minds. We will respect each child’s sleeping and eating schedules. Our center has an open door policy and will provide each parent with a daily log describing their child’s day. Parents will provide diapers, wipes, bottles, and baby food.

Two/ Three Year-Old Programs

Children will continue to discover the world and each other through a developmentally appropriate program. They begin to role model and work together, increasing their vocabulary and building social skills. The mornings will follow a pre-school format followed by lunch, rest time, and play. A nutritious lunch and two snacks will be provided.
